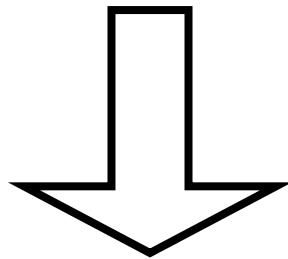

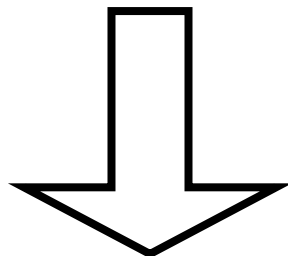

# **Facilities and Healthcare Engineers Association Scholarship**

**Due: May 4, 2012**

**The Facilities and Healthcare Engineers Association's (FHEA) purpose is to advance the development of engineering or facilities management in all types of facilities. This organization is organized exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes and is not for profit.**

**In an effort to promote and advance the field of engineering or facilities management, FHEA is sponsoring awards up to \$1,000 in scholarship money to deserving undergraduate students. Eligible students must be enrolled in accredited colleges, universities or technical schools that would enable the student to enter or to be updated in engineering or facilities management for all types of facilities.**

**Scholarship applications will be reviewed by a committee designated by the Board of Directors of FHEA. This committee will recommend to the board the frequency and monetary amount of the scholarships to be awarded. Final decisions will be by a vote of the Board of Directors.**

**Scholarship winners will be awarded their grants in June of the current year. The Board will periodically review the progress of the student. This review should be proactive and in the interest of the student regarding successful completion of the course of study. The Board may recommend changes in the support and encouragement provided for the recipient.**

- Involvement with any aspect of BHS Theatre Arts for at least 2 school years
- Completion of all items listed under SUBMISSIONS

#### SUBMISSIONS:

- 1) Completed application form (attached)
- 2) Copy of college acceptance letter or letter of intent
- 3) Extra-curricular résumé of your performing arts participation throughout your high school career. Be sure to include shows, musicals, plays, parts, church plays, community theatre, as well as any community service, church work, volunteer work, jobs obtained, etc., for the past 4 years. (Please include years – i.e., Showcase '09, etc)
- 4) An essay on the topic *“How My Involvement in BHS Theatre Arts Has Impacted My Life.”* Essay should be submitted on a separate page and should be double-spaced, no more than 2 pages in length, and printed using a 12 point font. **IMPORTANT: *Please refrain from including your name or any other personal information that may identify yourself to the reader.***

Completed applications and all supporting documents should be turned in to Mr. Smith by **3pm on the first Friday in May, (May 4)** and will be evaluated by the TSC Scholarship Committee.

Essays will be judged on 1) content and relevance to theme, 2) organization, grammar, and clarity, and 3) overall impression.

- Demonstrate strong scholastic achievement by maintaining a GPA of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Demonstrate leadership and character through extra curricular activities, service in school and in the community, volunteer involvement and paid work experience
- Select a major that leads to a career in law, dentistry, nursing or medicine

# Michigan Tuition Incentive Program

**Award: Up to two full years of college tuition fully paid,  
and an additional \$1000 for the following two years**

The State of Michigan Tuition Incentive Program (TIP) helps provide full tuition for a number of two-year (Associate Degree) programs for students who are TIP eligible at participating Michigan colleges and universities.

If a student chooses to continue on to a four-year degree, \$1000 is available for each of the remaining two years.

**Eligibility:**

- Must have (or have had) Medicaid coverage for 24 months within a 36-consecutive month period. (Confirmed by Michigan DHS)
- Must complete an acceptance form before graduation
- Cannot use any other financial aid towards tuition (can only use towards room and board, books, supplies, and transportation)
